To Professional Higher Technical Course (TeSP):

All applications have to be presented at the university or polytechnic institution that students want to enrol. Each university or polytechnic institution has different application procedures depending on study program. This means different admission requirements, different deadlines and different documents.

To Bachelor's Degree Programmes:

In order to be eligible to bachelor's degree, students must hold the high-school diploma or legally equivalent qualification with the right examinations results. More information here: https://www.dges.gov.pt/en . Application can also be made through the following special entry routes:

- Students coming from the Portuguese education system through re-admission, degree change and transfer schemes;
- Holders of a Foundation Course Diploma (CET) or a Professional Higher Technical Course (TeSP);
- Adults aged more than 23 who have passed tailor-made examinations intended to assess their ability to pursue higher education studies;
- Holders of Intermediary or Graduate degree diplomas;

To Master's Degree Programmes:

According to the Portuguese Law, the following candidates are eligible for entry to the course of study leading to the *Mestre* degree:

- Holders of a *licenciado* degree or legally equivalent corresponding to the first cycle of higher education;
- Holders of a foreign higher degree awarded on completion of a first-cycle programme organised in the framework of the Bologna Process;
- Holders of a foreign higher degree which is deemed by the Technical-Scientific Committee of each IPT's School to meet the requirements of a *licenciado* degree.
- Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum which is deemed by each IPT's School as appropriate to access the programme.
