

Academic Calendar for Undergraduate Courses 2015/16 The Abrantes School of Technology

Enrolment/Registration Period: 4th – 14th September 2015

First Year students from the first national call: 7th – 11th September 2015

First Year students from the second national call: 24th – 28th September 2015

- Students wishing to progress to the next academic year, but who are still waiting for module results, should still proceed to enrol on the dates specified on the academic calendar. When outstanding module marks are made final, you should direct yourself to the Academic Services Department to register on those modules, participation on which had been awaiting approval.
- Registrations and alterations of module choices must only be made during the first week of classes each semester.
- For those module marks that are posted outside of the specified time periods below, students have 48 hours after the initial posting to register for exam resits.

1st Semester:

- Results for 2nd attempt Resits (*Recurso*) and of the Exam resits for mark betterment (*melhoria*) by 25th February.

2nd Semester:

- Results for the Special Exam Period (1st attempt) and Exam resits for mark betterment (*melhoria*) by at maximum 10 days after the assessment and 4 days before next assessment
- Results for 2nd attempt Resits (*Recurso*) and of the Exam resits for mark betterment (*melhoria*) by 27th July.
- Results for special Exam Period (including Training and Project) and Exam resits for mark betterment (*melhoria*) by 16th December.
