

## Accommodation

### **IPT Halls of Residence (Tomar and Abrantes Campuses and Mação)**

Abrantes and Tomar: the IPT offers accommodation in Halls of Residence. Students must fill in the Accommodation Application Form and send it to International Relations Office by fax or e-mail (please see contacts and the bottom of the last page). Nevertheless, admission is not guaranteed since there are not enough places for all applicants. Admission results are given out in September every year.

Our Halls of Residence have double and triple rooms with access to a common kitchen and a living room. In exceptional cases, the female hall of residence has single rooms that can be made available in the case of health problems or other mitigating circumstances if they are properly justified.

The rooms are fully furnished and equipped with bed linen and duvets, hand and bath towels. Linen towels are changed weekly. The common spaces are cleaned daily but the rooms should be cleaned by the students themselves. The kitchen is equipped with a cooker, a fridge and a microwave, but cutlery, crockery or cooking utensils have to be supplied by the students themselves.

Mação: the students may stay in Museum students residence for around 150,00 € /month (food and gas expenses not included), where they have access to double rooms with bed clothes included, washing machine, refrigerator and microwaves. Students must fill in the Accommodation Application Form and send it to International Relations Office by fax or e-mail (please see contacts and the bottom of the last page). Nevertheless, admission is not guaranteed since there are not enough places for all applicants.



### Rented Rooms or Rented Flats (Tomar and Abrantes and Mação)

Students can also rent a room in a family house or even rent a flat. Prices of room vary between € 100 and € 150 per month depending on the quality of the room and renting conditions. The price of a flat with 3 rooms is approximately € 400 monthly, depending on the quality of the room and renting conditions.

In Mação there are houses for renting for around 350/400 Euros a month (that you may divide with 2 or 3 students).

### Accommodation in a Private Halls of Residence in Tomar

Students studying in Tomar also have the possibility of renting an individual flat or a double flat in the Santa Marta Private Halls of Residence, 500 m away from the IPT Campus.

- **Individual flat** (room, kitchen, wc) = € 262.50/month.
- **Double flat** (two rooms, kitchen, wc) = € 315/month.

Cleaning: € 30 per person/month (optional).

This includes: Towels and sheets, additionally the kitchen is equipped with electrical equipment; access to the laundry is also included.

Kitchenware (dishes, knives and forks, pots, etc.) is not included.

### Accommodation on Your First Day in Tomar

In the short term, whilst you are looking for a definite place to live, there are halls of residence, guesthouses and a hotel in the city.
