

General Admissions Requirements

To Bachelor's Degree Programmes:

In order to be eligible to bachelor's degree, students must hold the high-school diploma or legally equivalent qualification. Application can also be made through the following special entry routes:

- * Students coming from the Portuguese education system through re-admission, degree change and transfer schemes;
- * Holders of a Foundation Course Diploma (CET);
- * Adults aged more than 23 who have passed tailor-made examinations intended to assess their ability to pursue higher education studies;
- * Holders of Intermediary or Graduate degree diplomas;
- * Students coming from foreign higher education.

To Master's Degree Programmes:

According to the Portuguese Law, the following candidates are eligible for entry to the course of study leading to the *Mestre* degree:

- * Holders of a *licenciado* degree or legally equivalent corresponding to the first cycle of higher education;
- * Holders of a foreign higher degree awarded on completion of a first-cycle programme organised in the framework of the Bologna Process;
- * Holders of a foreign higher degree which is deemed by the Technical-Scientific Committee of each IPT's School to meet the requirements of a *licenciado* degree.
- * Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum which is deemed by each IPT's School as appropriate to access the programme.
